

COVID-19 CORONAVIRUS

FLEETWOOD PLACE Visitor Protocols (as announced by Public Health Officer on March 18 2022)

- Visitors 12 and up must be fully vaccinated
- Visitors must wear a medical mask except for those that are two years of age and under
- Visitors 12 and over require to be rapid test by nasal swab (15 min)
 - rapid testing is done here by the screener
 - daily visitors only need to be rapid tested maximum 3 times a week
- Medical masks are mandatory for the duration of your visit
- Resident visits to take place only in their rooms and the courtyard. Residents may be taken out of the building
 - there is no visiting in hallways, or public spaces in the care home
 - you may bring in a leashed pet, please bring everything they will need ie watering dish, poop bags, etc
 - always notify the Nurse and sign resident out when taking on an outing. Resident should wear a mask when in the public
 - visitors are not permitted to attend any indoor activities
- Coordinate your visits with other family members as we have limited space for visiting in the resident's room
- Screening station is open from 10:00 to 5:00 pm 7 days a week (visitors do not need to leave at 5 pm). Hours may change during Summer.
- Please be patient when waiting as screening station may be busy at times with high volumes of visitors.
